here are some of our highlights of 2021.



We had over 13,000 views of our online services and content. That's 3,000 more than the previous year! People have watched from all over the world including across Canada, USA, Singapore, Philippines, the UK, Australia, & New Zealand.

This year our Hospitality Team and volunteers made over 720 delicious and healthy home-made meals that got delivered to individuals each and every month.
